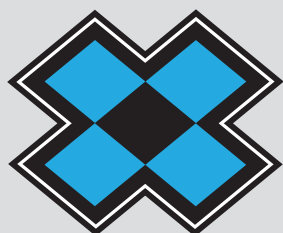

## WHY CHOOSE GEOGRAPHY AT MIAMI UNIVERSITY?

At the Department of Geography, our faculty have ongoing research that spans from local to global locations and across all scales and including human geography, geospatial analysis, biogeography, and planning. Our geospatial science students have access to the latest commercial (ESRI, ENVI, ERDAS Imagine) GIS and remote sensing software as well as open source coding and instruction (R, Python, JavaScript, Google Earth Engine, QGIS). You will be encouraged to take the opportunity to present your research on campus, state-wide, national, and international conferences .

Upon graduation, our students have found successful careers in geospatial technologies, environmental analysis and protection, urban and regional planning, environmental/engineering consulting, and university administration. Many have also gained acceptance and funding offers from top doctoral programs.

Miami University is located in Oxford, Ohio, approximately 35 miles northwest of Cincinnati, Ohio. Oxford is a charming college town that offers both a vibrant small-town atmosphere and rural amenities, yet is within an hour of both Cincinnati and Dayton, Ohio.
